7. Eritrea
8. Yemen
9. Iran
10. India

Interestingly, the first and the tenth countries listed are the only non-Muslim countries. It is only but right and proper that Christians should be properly informed before they go to prayer for these situations. So go, grab your copy and enliven your prayer for persecuted Christians with the help of OD.

GOOD NEWS: Last Friday the Supreme Appeal Court of Pakistan overruled the last action taken by Muslim clerics to overturn the earlier decision to drop all charges, including the death penalty, against Asia Bibi. She is now free to leave Pakistan with her entire family. We understand that Canada is her choice of a new life. Muslim clerics are determined to assassinate her wherever she goes. Please pray for Asia and her family, that the Lord will continue to bless and protect her and her family.
